SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

RELATING TO THE RECESS OF THE THIRTIETH LEGISLATURE, REGULAR
SESSION OF 2020.

1 WHEREAS, House Concurrent Resolution No. 1, Regular Session
2 of 2020, provided designated recess days for the Regular Session
3 of 2020 and was previously adopted by the House of
4 Representatives and the Senate; and

6 WHEREAS, in a matter of months the outbreak of the COVID-19
7 pandemic has spread to almost one hundred fifty countries
8 including the United States and consequently put the health,
9 safety, and welfare of the people of Hawaii at risk; and

11 WHEREAS, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention
12 (CDC) has officially issued guidelines to restrict gatherings of
13 fifty or more people for the next eight weeks to help control
14 the spread of COVID-19; and

16 WHEREAS, one recommendation of the CDC to diminish the risk
17 of spreading COVID-19 is to encourage social distancing in an
18 effort to minimize transmission of the infectious disease
19 between people; now, therefore,

21 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirtieth Legislature
22 of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2020, the House of
23 Representatives concurring, that the Regular Session of 2020 be
24 recessed for at least three days, beginning March 17, 2020; and

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that at the appropriate time the
27 Senate President and the Speaker of the House of Representatives
28 jointly declare through a signed memorandum the day and time to
29 reconvene the Regular Session of 2020; and
