# SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO EXAMINE AND  
PROVIDE A SAFE WAY FOR PEDESTRIANS TO CROSS HAWAII BELT  
ROAD.

1           WHEREAS, the intersection of Hawaii Belt Road and Lotus  
2 Blossom Lane on the island of Hawaii is routinely crossed by  
3 pedestrians; and

4  
5           WHEREAS, there is currently no crosswalk at the  
6 intersection of Hawaii Belt Road and Lotus Blossom Lane on the  
7 island of Hawaii; and

9           WHEREAS, at the intersection, there is regular  
10 bidirectional, vehicular traffic making pedestrian crossing  
11 unsafe; now, therefore,

12  
13           BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirtieth Legislature  
14 of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2020, the House of  
15 Representatives concurring, that the Department of  
16 Transportation is urged to:

18           (1) Study the traffic patterns within a one-half mile  
19 radius of the intersection of Hawaii Belt Road and  
20 Lotus Blossom Lane on the island of Hawaii and the  
21 associated dangers of a pedestrian crossing Hawaii  
22 Belt Road in the same area;

24           (2) Provide a plan that will create a safe way for  
25 pedestrians to cross Hawaii Belt Road in the  
26 designated area; and

27  
28           (3) Submit a report of its findings and recommendations to  
29 the Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the  
30 convening of the Regular Session of 2021.




