SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO INSTALL THREE RAISED
CROSSWALKS ON KUHINA STREET.

1 WHEREAS, pedestrian safety should be a priority for the
2 State and the counties; and

3
4 WHEREAS, motor vehicles, including city buses, have been
5 speeding on Kuhina Street near Fort Weaver Road in Ewa Beach, on
6 the island of Oahu; and

7
8 WHEREAS, numerous speed-related motor vehicle collisions on
9 Kuhina Street, including a recent car crash at a resident's
10 garage, have endangered students, faculty, staff, and other
11 pedestrians in the community; and

13 WHEREAS, many pedestrians cross Kuhina Street near routes
14 for city buses without the benefit of crosswalks; and

15
16 WHEREAS, raised pedestrian crosswalks, which are designed
17 to slow down motor vehicle traffic, can be an effective tool to
18 prevent collisions with pedestrians; now, therefore,

20 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirtieth Legislature
21 of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2020, the House of
22 Representatives concurring, that the City and County of Honolulu
23 is urged to install three raised crosswalks on Kuhina Street,
24 beginning from Kaimiloa Elementary School to North Road; and

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that city officials are urged to
27 seek input from the Ewa Neighborhood Board and local residents
28 regarding appropriate locations of the raised crosswalks; and

30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
31 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of
