# SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO INSTALL THREE RAISED  
CROSSWALKS ON PAPIPI ROAD.

1           WHEREAS, pedestrian safety, especially the safety of  
2 children, should be a priority for the State and the counties;  
3 and  
4

5           WHEREAS, motor vehicles, including city buses, have been  
6 speeding on Papipi Road in Ewa Beach, on the island of Oahu; and  
7

8           WHEREAS, a number of motor vehicles have collided with  
9 children and students on Papipi Road; and  
10

11           WHEREAS, raised pedestrian crosswalks, which are designed  
12 to slow down motor vehicle traffic, can be an effective tool to  
13 prevent collisions with pedestrians; now, therefore,  
14

15           BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirtieth Legislature  
16 of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2020, the House of  
17 Representatives concurring, that the City and County of Honolulu  
18 is urged to install three raised crosswalks on Papipi Road,  
19 beginning from Kapolei Parkway to Fort Weaver Road; and  
20

21           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that city officials are urged to  
22 seek input from the Ewa Neighborhood Board and local residents  
23 regarding appropriate locations of the raised crosswalks; and

25           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
26 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of  
27 Transportation, Mayor of the City and County of Honolulu, Chair  
28 of the Honolulu City Council, Director of the Honolulu  
29 Department of Transportation Services, Director of the Honolulu  
30 Department of Design and Construction, and Chair of the Ewa  
31 Neighborhood Board.
