## SENATE RESOLUTION

---

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF THE NAVY TO PROVIDE SECURITY SERVICES  
ON SAIPAN DRIVE IN WHITMORE VILLAGE ON THE ISLAND OF OAHU  
TO PREVENT ILLEGAL ACTIVITIES ON LAND ADJACENT TO A NAVAL  
FACILITY.

1           WHEREAS, the Naval Computer and Telecommunications Area  
2 Master Station Pacific in Whitmore Village on the island of Oahu  
3 provides operational management to all Pacific Naval  
4 Telecommunication System users and offers a variety of  
5 communication, telecommunication, and informational services to  
6 the United States Navy and United States Department of Defense;

9           WHEREAS, Saipan Drive in Whitmore Village provides the sole  
10 access into and out of the Naval Computer and Telecommunications  
11 Area Master Station Pacific facility; and

13           WHEREAS, the Hawaii Agribusiness Development Corporation  
14 and the City and County of Honolulu have noted a significant  
15 rise in illegal activity on and around Saipan Drive, including  
16 evidence of murder, auto theft, personal property theft, and  
17 illegal dumping; now, therefore,

19           BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirtieth Legislature  
20 of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2020, that the  
21 Department of the Navy is urged to provide security services on  
22 Saipan Drive in Whitmore Village on the island of Oahu to  
23 prevent illegal activities on land adjacent to a naval facility;

26           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
27 Resolution be transmitted to the Secretary of the Navy,  
28 Commander of the United States Pacific Fleet, Chairperson of the  
29 Board of Agriculture, and the Honolulu City Council member for  
30 District 2.
