SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII TO EXPLORE AN OPTIONAL
DINING PROGRAM FOR RESIDENCE HALL STUDENTS.

1 WHEREAS, the University of Hawaii requires mandatory
2 participation in the dining program for residence hall students;
3 and
4

5 WHEREAS, any residence hall student who fails to comply
6 with the dining requirements is subject to termination of their
7 student housing services contract; and
8

9 WHEREAS, dietary restrictions are not grounds for exemption
10 from a dining plan; and
11

12 WHEREAS, instead of allowing these residence hall students
13 to have an optional meal plan, they must seek out alternate
14 housing; and
15

16 WHEREAS, campus dining plans add to the already high cost
17 of attending the University of Hawaii; and

19 WHEREAS, students who reside in residence halls should be
20 given the option whether they wish to participate in the dining
21 program or not, similar to apartment residents, without being
22 forced to seek out alternative housing arrangements; now,
23 therefore,

25 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirtieth Legislature
26 of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2020, that the
27 University of Hawaii is requested to explore an optional dining
28 program for students residing in residence hall students; and
