# SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE GOVERNOR'S COORDINATOR ON HOMELESSNESS TO DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT FOR VARIOUS NEIGHBORHOODS ACROSS THE STATE SEPARATE REGIONAL PLANS THAT COORDINATE SHELTER FACILITIES AND SERVICES TO MEET THE NEEDS OF THE HOMELESS POPULATION AND CONCERNS OF IMPACTED COMMUNITIES.

1 WHEREAS, homelessness continues to be a significant issue  
2 throughout the State; and  
3

4 WHEREAS, an estimated fifteen thousand individuals in  
5 Hawaii are homeless; and  
6

7 WHEREAS, urban Honolulu receives most of the moneys  
8 allocated to address homelessness; and  
9

10 WHEREAS, the State is failing to collaborate with various  
11 local nonprofit organizations throughout the State to address  
12 homelessness; and

14 WHEREAS, homelessness is a crisis that necessitates  
15 increased collaboration between the State, counties,  
16 neighborhood boards, and nonprofit organizations; now,  
17 therefore,

19 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirtieth Legislature  
20 of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2020, that the  
21 Governor's Coordinator on Homelessness is requested to develop  
22 and implement separate regional plans for various neighborhoods  
23 across the State; and

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the regional plans include the  
26 coordination of shelter facilities and services of public  
27 agencies and nonprofit organizations to meet the needs of the  
28 homeless population and concerns of impacted communities; and


