Your Committee reviewed the personal history, resume, and statement submitted by Nadine Nishioka for service on the Hawai'i Commission for National and Community Service.

Your Committee received testimony in support of the nomination for the reappointment of Nadine Nishioka from one member of the Senate, one member of the House of Representatives, one member of the Honolulu City Council, Hawai'i Commission for National and Community Service, and one individual.

Upon review of the testimony, your Committee finds that Ms. Nishioka's background and dedication to serving the public qualify her to be reappointed to the Board of Directors of the Hawai'i Commission for National and Community Service. Your Committee notes that Ms. Nishioka has been Executive Director of the Moiliili Community Center since 2013 and has served on numerous nonprofit boards, including her present service as Chair of the Hawai'i Commission for National and Community Service. Your Committee finds that Ms. Nishioka has a thorough understanding of



the role and responsibilities of Commission members and her extensive experience in nonprofit administration will continue to enhance the effectiveness of the Hawai'i Commission for National and Community Service. Your Committee therefore recommends that Ms. Nishioka be reappointed to the Hawai'i Commission for National and Community Service based on her knowledge, background, and dedication to public service.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Higher Education that is attached to this report, your Committee, after full consideration of the background, experience, and qualifications of the nominee, has found the nominee to be qualified for the position to which nominated and recommends that the Senate advise and consent to the nomination.
