Your Committee on Health, to which was referred H.B. No. 139
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO HEALTH,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to effectuate its title.

H.B. No. 139 was introduced as a short-form bill, which is
sometimes referred to as a "vehicle" bill primarily used to
introduce a bill containing only a general idea as to the purpose
of the bill without specific details in the long form.

Your Committee has amended the bill to provide the
substantive contents of the bill in long form so that a public
hearing may be properly held on its substantive contents.

The purpose of this measure as amended is to promote the
health and safety of children by prohibiting the manufacture,
sale, and distribution of reusable food and drink containers
containing bisphenol A and intended for use by young children.

No testimony was submitted on this measure.
