Your Committee on Health, to which was referred H.B. No. 1659
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO HEALTH,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to effectuate its title.

H.B. No. 1659 was introduced as a short-form bill, which is
sometimes referred to as a "vehicle" bill primarily used to
introduce a bill containing only a general idea as to the purpose
of the bill without specific details in the long form.

Your Committee has amended the bill to provide the
substantive contents of the bill in long form so that a public
hearing may be properly held on its substantive contents.


The purpose of this measure is to authorize a pharmacy to
provide a customized patient medication package to any patient of
an institutional facility or any member of the general public upon
consent, with a valid prescription, and in compliance with
labeling and dispensing requirements.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Health that is attached to this report, your
Committee is in accord with the action to report out H.B. No.



1659, as amended herein, and recommends that it be recommitted to your Committee on Health, for the purpose of holding a public hearing thereon, in the form attached hereto as H.B. No. 1659, H.D. 1.
