Sir:

Your Committee on Health, to which was referred H.B. No. 1663
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO HEALTH,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to effectuate its title.

H.B. No. 1663 was introduced as a short-form bill, which is
sometimes referred to as a "vehicle" bill primarily used to
introduce a bill containing only a general idea as to the purpose
of the bill without specific details in the long form.

Your Committee has amended the bill to provide the
substantive contents of the bill in long form so that a public
hearing may be properly held on its substantive contents.

The purpose of this measure, as amended, is to protect the
health of Hawaii's consumers by requiring that:

- (1) All United States mainland milk shipped to and sold in
Hawaii is single pasteurized only and complies with all
handling, transportation, and distribution requirements
of the federal Food Safety Modernization Act, including
handling procedures, temperature verifications, and




proper refrigerated transportation of all perishable foods; and

- (2) Any processed milk or milk product must be entirely produced in the State in order to be labeled with any term or slogan that might imply that the milk or milk products are produced locally.

Your Committee has amended this measure by adopting the proposed H.D. 1.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Health that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the action to report out H.B. No. 1663, as amended herein, and recommends that it be recommitted to your Committee on Health, for the purpose of holding a public hearing thereon, in the form attached hereto as H.B. No. 1663, H.D. 1.
