Sir:

Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B. No. 2322, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO MASSAGE THERAPY,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to institute certain consumer protections with regard to massage therapy by:

- (1) Requiring the Board of Massage Therapy, rather than the Department of Health, to adopt and enforce sanitary rules for massage therapy establishments;
- (2) Repealing the penalty for unlicensed practice of massage therapy in favor of existing law that treats unlicensed activity as a misdemeanor; and
- (3) Increasing the fines for violations of the laws regulating massage therapy.


Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Board of Massage Therapy, American Massage Therapy Association - Hawaii Chapter, and IMUAlliance.
