The purpose of this measure is to:

- (1) Provide funding for the rental or lease of facilities through legislative appropriations and bond authorizations to the State Public Charter School Commission (Commission); and
- (2) Appropriate funds to the Commission for infrastructure costs, lease or rent assistance, and the repair and maintenance of network infrastructure for charter schools.
