Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B. No. 2692, H.D. 2, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO COMMUNITY CARE FOSTER FAMILY HOMES,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to increase the maximum number of hours a primary caregiver may be absent from a community care foster family home to fifty hours per week and twenty-three hours per day; provided that a substitute caregiver is present in the home.


