Your Committee on Water, Land, & Hawaiian Affairs, to which was referred H.B. No. 442 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO HAWAIIAN AFFAIRS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to effectuate its title.

H.B. No. 442 was introduced as a short-form bill, which is sometimes referred to as a "vehicle" bill primarily used to introduce a bill containing only a general idea as to the purpose of the bill without specific details in the long form.

Your Committee has amended the bill to provide the substantive contents of the bill in long form so that a public hearing may be properly held on its substantive contents.


The purpose of this measure is to appropriate funds for two part-time project-based research archivist positions at the State Archives to provide research services, digitize project records, and make relevant records and primary source documents available to the public.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from one individual.
