Your Committees on Judiciary and Consumer Protection &
Commerce, to which was referred H.B. No. 704, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO COSMETICS,"

beg leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to prohibit manufacturers from
selling cosmetic products in the State that are tested on animals
on or after January 1, 2021.

The Humane Society of the United States, West Hawaii Humane
Society, Cruelty Free International, National Anti-Vivisection
Society, O'ahu County Committee on Legislative Priorities of the
Democratic Party of Hawai'i, Animal Rights Hawai'i, and many
individuals testified in support of this measure. The Personal
Care Products Council and one individual testified in opposition.

Your Committees have amended this measure by:

- (1) Preventing the counties from establishing any
prohibition on animal tests more restrictive than state
law; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity,
consistency, and style.



As affirmed by the records of votes of the members of your Committees on Judiciary and Consumer Protection & Commerce that are attached to this report, your Committees are in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No. 704, H.D. 1, as amended herein, and recommend that it pass Third Reading in the form attached hereto as H.B. No. 704, H.D. 2.
