<u>HB 2605</u> Status	RELATING TO TAXATION OF REAL ESTATE INVESTMENT TRUSTS. Disallows dividends paid deduction for real estate investment trusts. Applies to taxable years beginning after 12/31/2020. Sunsets 12/31/2023.	EDB, FIN
<u>HB 2627</u> Status	RELATING TO TAXATION. Provides that Chapter 1, Subchapter Z (with respect to opportunity zones), of the Internal Revenue Code shall not be operative for the purposes of state income tax law.	EDB, FIN
<u>HB 2075</u> Status	RELATING TO FILM TAX CREDIT. Increases the annual rolling cap for the Motion Picture, Digital media and Film Production Income Tax Credit.	EDB, FIN
<u>HB 1895</u> Status	RELATING TO AGRICULTURE. Authorizes agricultural entities to incorporate as general cooperatives.	EDB, CPC, FIN
<u>HB 1892</u> Status	RELATING TO A FOOD HUB PILOT PROGRAM. Requires the Department of Agriculture to establish a five-year food hub pilot program to increase access to local food. Provides for the award of grant funding by qualified applicants wishing to establish or expand a food hub. Requires reports to the Legislature. Appropriates funds.	EDB, FIN
