<p>SB 2313 Status & Testimony</p>	<p>RELATING TO EMPLOYMENT PRACTICES. Prohibits an employer from requiring an employee to enter into a nondisclosure agreement pertaining to sexual harassment or sexual assault. Prohibits an employer from retaliating against an employee for disclosing or discussing sexual harassment or sexual assault.</p>	<p>LCA, JDC</p>
<p>SB 2193 Status & Testimony</p>	<p>RELATING TO EMPLOYMENT DISCRIMINATION. Limits the convictions that may be used in employment decisions from all convictions in the most recent ten years to felony convictions that occurred in the most recent five years and misdemeanor convictions that occurred in the most recent three years.</p>	<p>LCA, JDC</p>
<p>SB 2543 Status & Testimony</p>	<p>RELATING TO MEDICAL CANNABIS. Prohibits an employer from discriminating against a person in hiring, termination, or condition of employment based on the person's status as a medical cannabis cardholder, under certain conditions. Specifies that an employer may use a fit for duty test as a tool for medical cannabis users in potentially dangerous occupations.</p>	<p>LCA, CPH/JDC</p>
