<u>SB 3057</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO THE STATE CAPITOL. Establishes the position of a tour guide within the public access room to conduct tours of the state capitol. Appropriates funds to establish the position of a tour guide.	LCA, WAM
<u>SB 3131</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO STATE CAPITOL TOURS. Requires the governor to implement a state capitol tour program for volunteer docents to conduct tours of the capitol building and grounds. Appropriates funds.	LCA, WAM
<u>SB 3096</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO STATE HOLIDAYS. Reestablishes La Ku'oko'a, Hawaiian Recognition Day, as an official state holiday.	LCA, WAM
