PAPER: 10 copies (including an original) to Room 322 in the State Capitol;



Testimony submitted will be placed on the legislative website. This public posting of testimony on the website should be considered when including personal information in your testimony.

This three-minute policy will be enforced to ensure fairness and adequate consideration to all bills.**
