Requires no less than a one-half mile buffer zone for the construction, modification, or expansion of a waste or disposal facility. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD2)

Appropriates funds. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD2)




Testimony submitted will be placed on the legislative website. This public posting of testimony on the website should be considered when including personal information in your testimony.
