Requires the State Historic Preservation Division to contract its review
of proposed state projects, projects on privately owned historic
property, and projects affecting historic properties to third-party
consultants if the projects involve the development of affordable
housing and the division will not be able to complete its review within
60 days.

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW


Testimony submitted will be placed on the legislative website. This public posting of testimony on the website should be considered when including personal information in your testimony.

This three-minute policy will be enforced to ensure fairness and adequate consideration to all bills.
