HB1603	RELATING TO TRANSIENT ACCOMMODATIONS. Requires that advertisements for rates for transient accommodations include all mandatory fees, except for taxes imposed by the State or county.	TIA/CPC, FIN
HB1612	RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION. Ensures the collection of the state general excise tax in instances in which the transportation of passengers is furnished by common carriers by the use of aircraft when the collection of the tax is not prohibited by federal law. Limits imposition of tax to flights that occur within the airspace of a single island of the State.	TRN, FIN
HB1685	RELATING TO TAXATION. Establishes an income tax credit for investment in qualified businesses that develop cybersecurity and artificial intelligence.	EDB, FIN

HB1686	RELATING TO SUSTAINING HAWAII. Requires that 1% of all assessments, fees, fines, penalties, reimbursements, and taxes collected by the Insurance Division be deposited into a special fund in the Department of Land and Natural Resources to be used for countermeasures against climate change.	EEP/WLH, FIN
HB1697	RELATING TO THE GENERAL EXCISE TAX. Exempts the sales of feminine hygiene products from the general excise tax.	HLT, FIN
HB1755	RELATING TO FIRE PROTECTION. Authorizes the State Fire Council to administer and expend funds from the reduced ignition propensity cigarette program special fund to support statewide fire prevention and safety programs.	LAB, FIN
HB1830	RELATING TO TAXATION. Exempts the sale of precious metal bullion from the general excise tax.	EDB, FIN
HB1928	RELATING TO DEVELOPMENT DISTRICTS. Establishes the Pulehunui community development district on the island of Maui as a community development district within the authority of the Hawaii Community Development Authority. Authorizes the Hawaii Community Development Authority to obtain various forms of financial aid from the federal government for projects of the authority.	WLH, FIN
HB1930	RELATING TO TAXATION. Increases the amount of the rental motor vehicle surcharge tax from \$5 to \$8.	TRN, FIN
HB1957	RELATING TO TAX CREDITS. Increases the adjusted gross income eligibility cap for the income tax credit for low-income household renters from \$30,000 to \$50,000. Increases the amount used for calculating the credit from \$50 to \$200.	HSG, FIN
HB1973	RELATING TO NON-GENERAL FUNDS. Abolishes, repeals, or reclassifies various non-general funds of the Department of Transportation.	TRN, FIN
HB2028	RELATING TO THE CONVEYANCE TAX. Adjusts conveyance tax rates for non-residents who are not active military members.	CPC, FIN
