House Committee on Transportation

The Department of Transportation (DOT), **supports** this bill to install depth gauge signs along public highways that lies within a special flood hazard area and is prone to flooding.

According to the manual on uniform traffic control devices, each intersection would require four depth gauge signs at a cost of \$1000 per sign or \$4,000 for each intersection where the depth gauge signs are installed.

Sites are currently being prioritized as part of DOT's resiliency study. Methods of signage and alerting the public through signs and electronic devices are being considered.
