House Committee on Transportation

The Department of Transportation **offers comments** and believes this bill is unnecessary. We are moving forward with a widening of H-1 from Waiwa to Halawa that will provide the additional capacity necessary for contemplation of a future P.M. zipper. This project will not be completed until 2023.

The cost of modifying the system for a P.M. zipper is estimated to be on the order of \$70 million. We are in the process of reviewing options to minimize costs.
