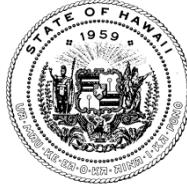

S.B. 2260
RELATING TO CIVIL IDENTIFICATION CARDS

House Committee on Judiciary

The Department of Transportation offers **comments** to S.B.2260 which repeals the minimum age requirement to obtain a civil identification card in the State.

The Transportation Security Administration airport security does not require children under 18 years of age to provide identification when traveling within the U.S.

It is unclear when possessing a state identification card would be beneficial for a minor under 10 years old given the cost of \$40 for an 8-year card.

Allowing minors to apply for and to be issued a state identification card will impact the already busy lines experienced by all counties due to the Department of Homeland Security's announcement that established October 1, 2020 as their full compliant enforcement date of REAL ID cards for intrastate/ interstate travel.
