Aloha Chair Takumi, Vice Chair Ichiyama and members of the committee:

Servco is in strong support of SB 3008 SD1 HD1, which exempts hydrogen fuels from measurement requirements of petroleum products.

The definition of fuel in the current law is broad and does not exclude hydrogen. Therefore, it implies that hydrogen must be sold on the basis of measure. There is currently no means for the State to measure and certify a hydrogen dispenser. The supporting infrastructure is not in place; technical expertise is needed and equipment needs to be imported. Servco's hydrogen fueling station in Mapunapuna was the first publicly accessible station in Hawaii.

SB 3008 SD1 HD1 will help promote the development of more public hydrogen stations.

Thank you for the opportunity to offer comments in support. We ask for your favorable consideration in passing the bill with a clean effective date.
