A BILL FOR AN ACT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the 2 State of Hawaii the sum of \$9,629,159 or so much thereof as may 3 be necessary to the senate for the following expenses: The sum of \$8,640,409 for defraying any and all 4 (1)session and nonsession expenses of the senate up to 5 and including June 30, 2022, including the 2021 6 7 regular session, thirty-first legislature of the State of Hawaii and pre-session expenses and the expenses of any committee or committees established during the interim between the 2021 and 2022 regular sessions; 10 The sum of \$977,500 for defraying the expenses of the 11 (2) legislative information system for cost items such as 12 hardware, software, consultants, installation, 13 14 materials, supplies, and other related costs 15 associated with the legislative information system 16 that have been or will be incurred; and

1	(3) The sum of \$11,250 for defraying the cost of the

15	only with the approval of the speaker of the house of

11	fiscal year 2021-2022 to be deposited into the audit revolving

14	SECTION 8	. There is appropriated out of the audit
