A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ANIMAL CONTROL SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that section 143-16,
- 2 Hawaii Revised Statutes, is an outdated statute and is no longer
- 3 relevant to the State's needs. The requirement that the county
- 4 of Kauai contract solely with the Kauai humane society for
- 5 animal control services has been superseded by the county's
- 6 ability to offer public contracts to other animal control
- 7 service providers.
- 8 The legislature also finds that construction of the animal
- 9 shelter or "dog pound" authorized by section 143-16, Hawaii
- 10 Revised Statutes, has been completed, making the provision no
- 11 longer necessary.
- 12 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to repeal section
- 13 143-16, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 143-16, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
