## ACT 097 S.B. NO. <sup>324</sup> H.D. 1 C.D. 1

# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE PRACTICE OF MEDICINE.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the definition of
 the practice of medicine was last amended in 2008 to include a
 distinct definition of osteopathic medicine. The legislature
 further finds that medical doctors and osteopathic doctors are
 both physicians of equivalent education and training and should
 be regulated as such.

Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to establish a
definition of the practice of medicine that provides uniformity
of practice for both medical and osteopathic physicians.

10 SECTION 2. Section 453-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 11 amended to read as follows:

12 "\$453-1 Practice of medicine defined. For the purposes of 13 this chapter, the practice of medicine by a physician or an 14 osteopathic physician includes the use of drugs and 15 medicines[7]; surgery; manual medicine; water[7]; 16 electricity[7]; hypnotism[7]; telehealth; the interpretation of

13	This section shall not amend or repeal the law respecting	
14	the treatment of those affected with Hansen's disease.

16	the utilization of full methods of diagnosis and treatment in	
17	physical and mental health and disease, including the	
18	prescribing and administration of drugs and biologicals of all	
19	kinds, operative surgery, obstetrics, radiological, and other	
20	electromagnetic emissions, and placing special emphasis on the	
21	interrelation of the neuro-musculoskeletal system to all other	

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1 body-systems, and the amelioration of disturbed structure-

2 function relationships by the clinical application of the

3 osteopathic diagnosis and therapeutic skills for the maintenance

4 of health and treatment of disease.]"

5 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
