A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR CARRIER PENALTIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Section 271-27, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended by amending subsection (h) to read as follows: Any motor carrier or lessor, or any officer, agent, 3 employee, or representative thereof, who fails or refuses to 4 5 comply with any provision of this chapter, or any rule, requirement, or order thereunder, and any person located in this 6 State, or any officer, agent, employee, or representative of any 7 such person, who engages the services of any motor carrier or 8 lessor, or any officer, agent, employee, or representative 9 10 thereof, who fails or refuses to comply with any provision of this chapter, or any rule, requirement, or order, may be 11 assessed a civil penalty for an amount determined by the 12 13 commission subject to this section payable to the State in a 14 sum:
- Up to \$1,000 for each offense; [and] 15 (1)
- 16 In the case of a continuing violation, not less than (2) \$50 and not more than \$500 for each additional day 17 18 during which the failure or refusal continues [+]; and

1	(3) Up to \$5,000 for each fourth or subsequent violation
