A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Act 30, Session Laws of Hawaii 2020, is amended
- 2 by amending sections 9 and 10 to read as follows:
- 3 "SECTION 9. There is appropriated out of the state highway
- 4 fund the sum of [\$800,000] \$2,000,000 or so much thereof as may
- 5 be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021; \$400,000 or so much as
- 6 may be necessary for fiscal year 2021-2022; and \$400,000 or so
- 7 much as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 to be
- 8 deposited into the photo red light imaging detector systems
- 9 special fund.
- 10 SECTION 10. There is appropriated out of the photo red
- 11 light imaging detector systems special fund the sum of
- [\$800,000] \$2,000,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for
- 13 fiscal year 2020-2021; \$400,000 or so much as may be necessary
- 14 for fiscal year 2021-2022; and \$400,000 or so much as may be
- 15 necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for purposes of establishing
- 16 the photo red light imaging detector systems pilot program[-];
- 17 provided that the moneys appropriated for fiscal year 2020-2021

- 1 shall not lapse at the end of that fiscal year; provided further
- 2 that all moneys appropriated for fiscal year 2020-2021 that are
- 3 unexpended or unencumbered as of June 30, 2022, shall lapse to
- 4 the credit of the photo red light imaging detector systems
- 5 special fund.
- 6 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 7 transportation for the purposes of this Act; provided that the
- 8 department of transportation shall expend \$112,602 in fiscal
- **9** year [2020-2021 and fiscal year] 2021-2022, fiscal year
- 10 2022-2023, and fiscal year 2023-2024 for the funding of one
- 11 permanent full-time (1.0 FTE) deputy prosecuting attorney
- 12 position within the department of the prosecuting attorney of
- 13 the city and county of Honolulu."
- 14 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 16 SECTION 3. This Act, upon its approval, shall take effect
- 17 retroactively on June 30, 2021.
