Section 302L-1.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows: 2 "(c) Except for the superintendent of education, directors 3 of state departments, president of the University of Hawaii, 4 5 chief executive officer of Kamehameha Schools, and the executive director of the Hawaii Association of Independent Schools, or their designees, the members of the board shall serve staggered 7 8 terms as follows: 9 (1) The representative of center-based program providers 10 shall serve a two-year term; The representative of family child care program 11 (2) providers shall serve a three-year term; 12 (3) The representative of family-child interaction 13 learning program providers shall serve a three-year 14 15 term; The representative of philanthropic organizations that 16 (4) support early learning shall serve a two-year term; 17
