### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE CAPITOL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 6E-34.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 repealed. 3 ["{\$6E-34.5} State capitol; state capitol management committee; established; oversight and management; powers and 4 5 duties. (a) The oversight and management of the state capitol 6 and its grounds and facilities shall be vested in the state 7 capitol management committee established pursuant to this 8 section. 9 (b) There is established the state capitol management 10 committee, which shall be composed of the following members or 11 their respective designees: 12 (1) The governor's chief of staff; 13 (2) The comptroller; 14 (3) The director of public safety; 15 (4) Two members of the senate as appointed by the 16 president of the senate;

16	state capitol management committee pursuant to section 6E-34.5,		
17	Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall remain in full force and effect		
18	until amended or repealed by the department of accounting and		
19	general services, governor, senate, or house of representatives		
20	as applicable.
