BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

9	department of budget and finance shall have oversight authority
10	over the fund and may make periodic financial audits of the

1	including but not limited to, reducing cigarette-smoking and
2	tobacco use among youth and adults through education and
3	enforcement activities, and controlling and preventing chronic
4	diseases where tobacco is a risk factor.
5	(d) The Hawaii tobacco-prevention and control trust fund
6	may receive appropriations, contributions, grants, endowments,
7	or gifts in cash or otherwise from any source, including the
8	State, corporations or other businesses, foundations,
9	government, individuals, and other interested parties; provided
10	that any appropriations made by the State shall not supplant or
11	diminish the funding of existing tobacco prevention and control
12	programs or any health related programs funded in whole or in
13	part by the State.
14	(c) The assets of the Hawaii tobacco prevention and
15	control trust fund shall consist of:
16	(1) Moneys appropriated under section 328L-2(b)(2);
17	(2) Moneys appropriated to the Hawaii tobacco prevention
18	and control trust fund by the state, county, or
19	federal-government;
20	(3) Private contributions of cash or property; and
21	(4) Income and capital gains earned by the trust fund.



1	(f) The aggregate principal sum deposited in the Hawaii
2	tobacco prevention and control trust fund shall be invested by
3	the entity selected under subsection (a) in a manner intended to
4	maximize the rate of return on investment of the trust fund
5	consistent with the objective of preserving the trust-fund's
6	principal.
7	(g) If the entity selected under subsection (a) is
8	dissolved, the director of health, with the concurrence of the
9	governor, shall select a successor entity. If the Hawaii
10	tobacco prevention and control trust fund is terminated, the
11	moneys remaining in the trust fund shall revert back to the
12	State and shall be deemed to be trust moneys.
13	(h) The administration of the Hawaii tobacco prevention
14	and control trust fund shall be advised by the tobacco
15	prevention and control advisory board created under
16	section 328L-6."]
17	SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
18	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$5,700,000 or so much
19	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2021-2022 and the
20	same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
21	2022-2023 to be for tobacco prevention and control purposes.

Hawaii Tobacco Settlement Special Fund; Hawaii Tobacco Prevention and Control Trust Fund; Repeal; General Fund; Appropriation

Description:

Repeals the Hawaii tobacco prevention and control trust fund and transfers unencumbered balances to the general fund. Specifies that Hawaii tobacco settlement special fund moneys shall only be deposited into the University revenue-undertakings fund until 7/1/2033. Appropriates general funds to the department of health for tobacco prevention and control. (HD1)
