A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FISCAL RESPONSIBILITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the 2010-2013 tax
 review commission concluded that a comprehensive review of
 Hawaii's tax structure was necessary to determine how the tax
 structure fared during the great recession of 2008-2010 and
 whether the tax structure was adequate to meet the needs of the
 twenty-first century.

7 One recommendation of the tax review commission was to
8 establish a commission similar to the federal government's
9 National Commission on Fiscal Responsibility and Reform, also
10 known as the Simpson-Bowles Commission, with authority to review
11 and make recommendations on expenditures and revenue

12 enhancement.

13 The tax review commission noted that the tax burden on
14 Hawaii's taxpayers would be severe if the approach was solely to
15 enhance revenue. Therefore, the expenditure component must be
16 part of a solution that promotes long-term financial stability
17 and prosperity for the State and its residents.

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The	purpose of this Act is to establish a commission with
the autho	rity to review and make recommendations on
expenditu	res, revenue enhancement, and improving tax policy.
SECT	ION 2. (a) There is established the state commission
on fiscal	responsibility within the department of taxation for
administrative purposes.	
(b)	The state commission on fiscal responsibility shall
consist of the following members:	
(1)	Two members to be appointed by the governor, at least
	one of whom is currently serving or has formerly
	served on the state council on revenues;
(2)	Two members of the senate, to be appointed by the
	president of the senate, one of whom shall serve as
	co-chair of the commission;
(3)	Two members of the house of representatives, to be
	appointed by the speaker of the house of
	representatives, one of whom shall serve as co-chair
	of the commission;
(4)	The director of taxation or the director's designee;
(5)	The director of finance or the director's designee;

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1	(6)	One representative from a nonprofit legal services
2		provider; and
3	(7)	One representative from a nonprofit organization whose
4		mission including analyzing and examining tax and
5		spending policies at the state and local government

7	(c)	The commission shall:
8	(1)	Identify policies for the State to improve revenue
9		enhancement in the medium term and achieve fiscal
10		security over the long term;
11	(2)	Research and propose recommendations related to state
12		spending; and
13	(3)	Identify steps needed to improve tax policy to create
14		a more balanced and progressive tax structure.
15	(d)	Members of the commission shall serve without
16	compensat	ion, but shall be reimbursed for necessary expenses,
17	including	travel expenses, incurred in the performance of their
18	official	duties.
19	(e)	The commission shall submit a report of its findings
20	and recom	mendations to the legislature no later than twenty days
21	prior to	the convening of the regular session of 2023. The

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report shall require the approval of at least two-thirds of the
 total commission members.
 (f) The commission shall cease to exist on June 30, 2024.
 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2021.
