

### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ONLINE EARLY EDUCATION.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 302L, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
3	and to read as follows:		
4	"§302L- Online early learning program. (a) There is		
5	established within the Executive Office on Early Learning, the		
6	online early learning program to provide children who are four		
7	years of age with access to online early learning content.		
8	(b) The office shall contract the services of an online		
9	early learning service provider using competitive sealed bidding		
10	pursuant to section 103D-302; provided that the service provider		
11	shall be:		
12	(1) A nonprofit corporation subject to section 501(c)(3)		
13	of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended; and		
14	(2) Able to demonstrate a history of successful online		
15	early learning programs, as verified by independent,		
16	valid, and reliable evaluations.

1	<u>(c)</u>	The office shall require the service provider to	
2	submit a	quarterly report to the Early Learning Board containing	
3	the following:		
4	(1)	The number of families volunteering to participate in	
5		the program;	
6	(2)	The number of families selected to participate in the	
7		program;	
8	(3)	The number of families requesting a computer or home	
9		<pre>internet service;</pre>	
10	(4)	The number of families that are provided a computer or	
11		home internet service;	
12	(5)	The participating families' frequency of using the	
13		instructional software provided by the program;	
14	(6)	Parental feedback on the program; and	
15	(7)	Student performance on prekindergarten and	
16		kindergarten readiness assessment.	
17	<u>(d)</u>	For the purposes of this Act, "online early learning	
18	program"	means a program that meets all of the following	
19	criteria	as outlined in Hawaii Revised Statutes 302L-1.5	
20	subsection	on (d).

- 1 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2021-2022 and the
- 4 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 5 2022-2023 for the Executive office on early learning to
- 6 establish an online early learning program for children who are
- 7 four years of age.
- 8 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the Executive
- 9 Office on Early Learning for the purposes of this Act.
- 10 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon approval.
