A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FOOD SUSTAINABILITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. (a) Pursuant to section 226-55, Hawaii Revised 2 Statutes, the department of agriculture, in coordination with 3 the office of planning, shall prepare and periodically update 4 the agricultural functional plan to include among other 5 agricultural economic updates, seafood sustainability that 6 expands the State's priority on food by including wild seafood 7 as a viable food source. 8 As part of the updated agricultural functional plan, 9 which shall include among other agricultural economic updates, 10 seafood sustainability, the department of agriculture and the 11 office of planning shall consider the following: 12 Establishing objectives, policies, and actions related (1)13 to seafood sustainability; 14 (2) Researching the agricultural and economic impact that 15 wild seafood has on food self-sufficiency in the 16 State, including its influence on non-commercial

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1		consumption, such as community sharing and fisher
2		household consumption, and exports;
3	(3)	Collecting data on the wholesale and retail sales of
4		wild seafood in the State;
5	(4)	Classifying and regulating wild seafood as a food
6		commodity in the State; and
7	(5)	Incorporating seafood sustainability into the state
8		agricultural functional plan related to increased food
9		security and food self-sufficiency.
10	(C)	The governor shall submit the agricultural functional
11	plan purs	uant to section 226-56, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
12	including	any proposed legislation, to the legislature no later
13	than twen	ty days prior to the convening of the regular session
14	of 2023.	
15	(d)	For the purposes of this section, "wild seafood" means
16	naturally-born or hatchery-raised fish and shellfish harvested	
17	in the wild through commercial, recreational, or subsistence	
18	fishing,	but excluding net-pen aquacultural or other farm-raised
19	fish.	
20	SECT	ION 2. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2050.

Requires the department of agriculture, in coordination with the office of planning, to prepare and periodically update the agricultural functional plan to include among other agricultural economic updates, seafood sustainability that expands the State's priority on food by including wild seafood as a viable food source.
