A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CITATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 291, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
- 3 designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "<u>\$291-</u> <u>Electronic citation surcharge.</u> (a) In addition
- 5 to any other civil penalties ordered by the court, a person who
- 6 violates any provision under this part shall be ordered to pay
- 7 an electronic citation surcharge of \$2.
- 8 (b) The person shall pay the surcharge to the clerk of the
- 9 court. The surcharge shall be deposited with the director of
- 10 finance, who shall credit the surcharge to the electronic
- 11 citation special fund established under section 291C-C."
- 12 SECTION 2. Chapter 291C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 13 amended by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and
- 14 to read as follows:
- 15 "PART . ELECTRONIC CITATION PROGRAM
- 16 §291C-A Definitions. As used in this part:

- 1 "Electronic citation" means the process of transmitting
- 2 traffic, misdemeanor, or other citations and law enforcement
- 3 data via electronic means to the clerk of the court.
- 4 §291C-B Electronic citation surcharge. (a) In addition
- 5 to any other civil penalties ordered by the court, a person who
- 6 violates any provision under this chapter shall be ordered to
- 7 pay an electronic citation surcharge of \$2.
- 8 (b) The person shall pay the surcharge to the clerk of the
- 9 court, who shall credit the surcharge to the electronic citation
- 10 special fund established under section 291C-C.
- 11 §291C-C Electronic citation program; electronic citation
- 12 special fund; establishment. (a) There is established, within
- 13 the judiciary, an electronic citation program that shall be
- 14 funded and sustained through the electronic citation special
- 15 fund.
- 16 (b) There is established in the state treasury the
- 17 electronic citation special fund, into which shall be deposited:
- 18 (1) Electronic citation fees collected pursuant to traffic
- 19 misdemeanors or other violations;
- 20 (2) Appropriations by the legislature to the special fund;
- **21** and

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- (3) All moneys received from public or private sources for
 the purposes of this fund.
- 3 (c) Moneys in the electronic citation special fund shall
- 4 be distributed by the judiciary, in accordance with rules
- 5 adopted pursuant to subsection (d), to the respective county
- 6 police departments and clerk of the court to defray expenses
- 7 related to the establishment and maintenance of the electronic
- 8 citation program.
- 9 (d) The judiciary shall adopt rules to implement this
- 10 section. The rules shall establish a formula by which the
- 11 moneys in the electronic citation special fund shall be
- 12 distributed to the respective law enforcement agencies and to
- 13 the administrative director of the courts and provide how each
- 14 shall expend the moneys for the purposes of an electronic
- 15 citation program."
- 16 SECTION 3. Section 291D-9, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 17 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
- "(c) In addition to any monetary assessment imposed for a
- 19 traffic infraction $[\tau]$ and the cost for an electronic citation
- 20 surcharge, the court may impose additional assessments for:

- (1) Failure to pay a monetary assessment by the scheduled
 date of payment; or
- 3 (2) The cost of service of a penal summons issued pursuant4 to this chapter."
- 5 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
- 6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 7 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2021-2022 for
- 8 start-up costs associated with the electronic citation program.
- 9 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for
- 10 the purposes of this Act.
- 11 SECTION 5. In codifying the new sections added by
- 12 section 2 of this Act, the revisor of statutes shall substitute
- 13 appropriate section numbers for the letters used in designating
- 14 the new sections in this Act.
- 15 SECTION 6. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 16 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 17 begun before its effective date.
- 18 SECTION 7. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 19 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 20 SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
- 21 provided that section 4 shall take effect on July 1, 2021.
