#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 127A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is									
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated									
3	and to read as follows:									
4	"§127A- Medical facilities; elective surgeries. (a)									
5	Whenever the governor declares a state of emergency for the									
6	entire State or any portion thereof, or a mayor declares a local									
7	state of emergency for the county or any portion thereof, or									
8	when the State, or any portion thereof, is the subject of a									
9	health or pandemic emergency:									
10	(1) The governor shall assure the continuity of service by									
11	medical facilities, both publicly and privately owned,									
12	by regulating or, if necessary to the continuation of									
13	the service thereof, by taking over and operating the									
14	same; and									
15	(2) Any hospital, in its discretion, may suspend providing									
16	elective surgeries to address operational limits of									
17	the facility's bed capacity.
