A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC HOUSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that public housing
- 2 communities disproportionately lack broadband and digital equity
- 3 and access to quality educational opportunities and healthcare
- 4 services. This disparity has been exacerbated by the
- 5 coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic, as school, work,
- 6 and healthcare have shifted to online distance learning,
- 7 telecommuting, and telehealth, respectively. The lack of
- 8 broadband and digital equity may cause school children to drop
- 9 out of school due their inability to participate in distance
- 10 learning activities or complete homework assignments for which
- 11 an internet connection is required. The legislature further
- 12 finds that because distance learning is likely to continue
- 13 through 2021 and possibly into 2022, a continued lack of
- 14 broadband and digital equity in the State will expand
- 15 educational disparities throughout the State.
- 16 The legislature notes that Virginia has implemented
- 17 initiatives to increase access to broadband internet statewide,



- 1 including the more rural areas of Virginia. Similarly, the
- 2 legislature believes that an important first step for Hawaii to
- 3 expand broadband access to all residents of the State is to
- 4 improve the internet speeds and connection quality provided to
- 5 the residents of the Kuhio Park Terrace and Puuwai Momi public
- 6 housing complexes. Currently, in the Kuhio Park Terrace public
- 7 housing complex, which comprises two, sixteen-story towers, the
- 8 ground floors of the complex are able to access the internet
- 9 while some higher floors cannot.
- 10 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to require the
- 11 Hawaii public housing authority to establish a pilot program to
- 12 ensure that all housing units in the Kuhio Park Terrace and
- 13 Puuwai Momi public housing complexes are provided with
- 14 sufficient internet speeds and connection quality.
- 15 SECTION 2. (a) The Hawaii public housing authority shall
- 16 establish a pilot program to ensure that the internet speeds and
- 17 connection quality throughout each housing unit in the Kuhio
- 18 Park Terrace and Puuwai Momi public housing complexes are
- 19 sufficient for school children to participate in distance
- 20 learning activities without negatively impacting the use of the
- 21 internet by other residents.

12	(1) An ass	sessment of the pilot program, including:
13	(A) V	Whether the pilot program was successful in
14	ϵ	extending access to broadband internet to all
15	S	school children and residents at Kuhio Park
16	3	Cerrace and Puuwai Momi public housing complexes;
17	(B) A	An assessment of the speed and quality of the
18	k	proadband infrastructure installed at each
19		complex; and
20	(C) 5	The number of school children and residents who

1	(2)	An assessment of the feasibility of extending the	
2		pilot program to other public housing complexes	
3		statewide; and	
4	(3)	Any other findings and recommendations, including any	
5		proposed legislation.	
6	(d)	As used in this Act, "school children" means children	
7	attending public or private schools in grades kindergarten		
8	through twelve and residing in either the Kuhio Park Terrace or		
9	Puuwai Momi public housing complexes.		
10	(e)	The pilot program shall cease to exist on June 30,	
11	2023.		
12	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general		
13	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so		
14	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2021-2022 and		
15	the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal		
16	year 2022-2023 to be deposited into the public housing revolving		
17	fund.		
18	SECT	ION 4. There is appropriated out of the public housing	
19	revolving	fund the sum of \$ or so much thereof as may	
20	be necessary for fiscal year 2021-2022 and the same sum or so		
21	much ther	eof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for	

- 1 the Hawaii public housing authority to contract with one or more
- 2 private entities to install any necessary upgrades to the Kuhio
- 3 Park Terrace and Puuwai Momi public housing complexes' internet
- 4 infrastructures.
- 5 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii
- 6 public housing authority for the purposes of this Act.
- 7 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2021.
