BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 11-391, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

- 1 (3) Not contain false information about the time, date,
- place, or means of voting.
- 3 (b) Any multiple-page advertisement that is circulated,
