A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MINORS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 346-17.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (h) to read as follows: 3 For purposes of this section: 4 "Minor" means a person less than eighteen years of age. 5 "No cost emergency shelter and related services" means accommodation at no cost for a continuous period of no more than 6 thirty days, unless extended for emergency purposes and in compliance with subsection (b), including beds, meals, 8 9 individual showering facilities, transportation to and from the 10 place of shelter, and any of the following services as deemed 11 appropriate by the provider: Assistance with reunification with the family, legal 12 (1)13 quardian, or legal custodian of the minor; 14 (2) Referral to safe housing; 15 (3) Individual, family, and group counseling; 16 (4)Assistance in obtaining clothing;

17		neglect (CA/N) registry checks, background,
18		employment, and any other checks as may be required by
19		state or federal law on an annual basis for all

3	(3)	Serves no more than five minor children per day;
