## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that many residents
- 2 throughout the State have submitted complaints regarding the
- 3 growing noise pollution and disturbance from loud mufflers on
- 4 motor vehicles, primarily motorcycles. They claim that the
- 5 noise level adversely affects their sleep, particularly in the
- 6 early morning hours or late at night. The noise may have
- 7 impacts on public health and safety, as well as peaceful
- 8 enjoyment and quality of life.
- 9 The legislature further finds that while existing law
- 10 prohibits vehicle owners from installing mufflers that increase
- 11 the noise of their vehicle, the penalties are minimal and do
- 12 little to deter violators of the existing muffler laws. In
- 13 fact, violators are known to add the enhanced noise mufflers
- 14 after they have passed the county vehicle safety check.
- Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to enhance the
- 16 current laws by increasing the fines that may be issued for
- 17 violation of the loud muffler laws.

### H.B. NO. 288 H.D. 1

- 1 SECTION 2. Section 291-23, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "\$291-23 Penalty. Whoever is convicted of violating any
- 4 of the provisions of section 291-22 shall be fined [not] no more
- 5 than [\$100.] \$300."
- 6 SECTION 3. Section 291-24, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 7 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 8 "(c) Whoever violates this section shall be fined [not] no
- **9** more than [\$100.] \$300."
- 10 SECTION 4. Section 291-24.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 11 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- "(b) Any violation of this section shall constitute a
- 13 violation and shall be enforceable by police officers. The fine
- 14 for this violation shall be [not] no less than [\$25] \$100 nor
- 15 more than [\$250] \$300 for each separate offense. Any person who
- 16 violates the provisions of this section may be issued a summons
- 17 or citation for [such] the violation."
- 18 SECTION 5. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 19 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 20 begun before its effective date.

- 1 SECTION 6. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 3 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3021.
