A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE JUDICIAL COUNCIL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 601-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended to read as follows:

3 "§601-4 Judicial council. The supreme court shall provide 4 for the appointment of a judicial council which shall serve in 5 an advisory capacity only. The judicial council shall give 6 continuing consideration to the administration of justice in the 7 courts of the State. It shall make reports and recommendations biennially to the supreme court and also whenever deemed 8 9 advisable by the court. The meetings of the judicial council 10 shall be open to the public as provided in section 92-3; 11 provided that deliberations for the selection of nominees for 12 the campaign spending commission pursuant to section 11-311 and 13 state ethics commission pursuant to section 84-21 shall be 14 closed to the public. The chief justice shall be a member and 15 chairperson of the judicial council. The supreme court shall 16 appoint, from time to time, [such] a number of other members as 17 it deems necessary to be fairly representative, but not to

1 exceed fifteen, whose terms shall be in accordance with the 2 rules of the supreme court. The members of the judicial council 3 shall include laypersons as well as judges and lawyers. The members of the judicial council shall receive no compensation 4 5 for their service but they shall be reimbursed for their 6 traveling and other expenses incidental to attending meetings." 7 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
