A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO OUTDOOR ADVERTISING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

The legislature finds that the State's laws 1 SECTION 1. 2 regulating outdoor advertising are intended to promote and 3 protect the public health, safety, and welfare. Laws, rules, 4 and ordinances regulating and enforcing outdoor advertising are 5 necessary to prevent unreasonable distraction of motorists and 6 other motor vehicle operators, prevent interference with the 7 effectiveness of traffic regulations, protect Hawaii's natural 8 beauty, promote safety on the State's highways, and protect 9 residents' enjoyment of public spaces.

10 The legislature notes that penalties associated with 11 violations of outdoor advertising laws have not been updated in 12 decades, including one law that has remained unamended since its 13 enactment in 1966.

14 The purpose of this Act is to amend the fines and community 15 service penalties for violating Hawaii's outdoor advertising 16 laws.

than [\$25] <u>\$</u> nor more than [\$500,] <u>\$</u>, or 1 2 imprisoned not more than one month, or both. 3 In addition to subsection (a), any person acting (b) 4 knowingly, who is either: 5 (1) Responsible for posting material in violation of section 445-114; or 6 7 (2) The person organizing the event or the owner or 8 operator of the business advertised on the posted 9 material, 10 shall remove the material within seventy-two hours after receipt 11 of written notice of the posting or seventy-two hours after the 12 date of the event advertised on the posted material, whichever 13 occurs first. Failure to remove the posted material within the 14 time specified shall be punishable by an additional fine of not less than [\$100] <u>\$</u>_____ nor more than [\$200] <u>\$</u>_____ 15 per posted material, or community service of not less than [ten] 16 17 hours nor more than [twenty] hours, or both. Such additional penalties shall not be imposed unless the 18 person received written notice of the posting or was responsible 19 20 for posting material in violation of section 445-114."
