

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO VITAL STATISTICS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 338, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "\\$338- Certificates of stillbirth. The department of
- 5 health shall issue a certificate of stillbirth to the parent or
- 6 parents named on a fetal death certificate issued in the case of
- 7 a stillbirth, upon the request of the parent or parents. A
- 8 certificate may be requested and issued regardless of the date
- 9 on which the fetal death certificate was issued. The
- 10 certificate shall include the name given to the stillborn fetus,
- 11 upon the request of the parent or parents."
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 338-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 13 amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted
- 14 and to read as follows:
- ""Stillbirth" means the unintended intrauterine death of a
- 16 fetus that occurs after the clinical estimate of the twentieth
- 17 week of gestation."

1	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
2	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
3	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2021-2022 and
4	the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
5	year 2022-2023 for the department of health to modify the fetal
6	death reporting system, certificate ordering system, and
7	retaining of personnel necessary to implement this Act.
8	The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
9	of health for the purposes of this Act.
10	SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
11	SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2021.
