Complex 6 area superintendents for schools shall report directly to the 7 superintendent of education. The complex area superintendents 8 shall supervise the delivery of administrative and instructional 9 support services within their respective complex areas, 10 including: 11 Personnel, fiscal, and facilities support; (1) 12 (2) Monitoring of compliance with applicable state and 13 federal laws; 14 Curriculum development, student assessment, and staff (3) 15 development services; and 16 Special education programs and special schools within (4)17 the complex area."
