A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1		PART I
2	SECT	ION 1. Section 302A-604, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
3	amended t	o read as follows:
4	"§30	2A-604 Complex area superintendents. The
5	superinte	ndent of education, with the approval of the board,
6	shall app	oint complex area superintendents for schools. Complex
7	area supe	rintendents for schools shall report directly to the
8	superinte	ndent of education. The complex area superintendents
9	shall sup	ervise the delivery of administrative and instructional
10	support s	ervices within their respective complex areas,
11	including	:
12	(1)	Personnel, fiscal, and facilities support;
13	(2)	Monitoring of compliance with applicable state and
14		federal laws;
15	(3)	Curriculum development, student assessment, and staff
16		development services; and

1	(4) Special education programs and special schools within	
2	the complex area."	
3	PART II	
4	SECTION 2. The purpose of this part is to appropriate	
5	funds to implement a reorganization of the department of	
6	education.	
7	Specifically, the moneys appropriated and positions	
8	authorized in this part restructure the department of education	
9	by:	
10	(1) Dissolving the office of strategy, innovation, and	
11	performance and redeploying certain affected	
12	employment positions; and	
13	(2) Dissolving the office of information technology	
14	services and redeploying certain affected employment	
15	positions and decentralizing certain administrative	
16	support to each complex area,	
17	pursuant to the organizational chart that is included in the	
18	senate standing committee report of the senate committee on ways	
19	and means.	
20	The legislature notes that the office of strategy,	
21	innovation, and performance and the office of information	

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1	technology both include positions that are administratively
2	established pursuant to section 302A-1116, Hawaii Revised
3	Statutes. The legislature directs the department of education
4	to redeploy certain positions in these affected offices in
5	accordance with the reorganization effectuated by this part.
6	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
7	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
8	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2021-2022 and
9	the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
10	year 2022-2023 for the salaries and benefits of the following
11	positions:
12	(1) Fifteen permanent full-time equivalent (15.0 FTE)
13	equity specialist II positions, to be housed within
14	the complex areas and to report directly to the
15	complex area superintendent for their respective
16	complex area; provided that each position shall
17	receive guidance and technical support from the civil
18	rights compliance branch within the office of talent
19	management;
20	(2) Fifteen permanent full-time equivalent (15.0 FTE)
21	career and technical education resource teacher

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1		positions to effectuate career readiness pathways for
2		students, to be housed within the complex areas and to
3		report directly to the complex area superintendent for
4		their respective complex area; provided further that
5		each position shall receive guidance and technical
6		support from the career readiness team within the
7		office of curriculum and instructional design;
8	(3)	Thirty permanent full-time equivalent (30.0 FTE) data
9		processing user support technician II positions to
10		assist with complex school connectivity and
11		information technology needs, to be housed within the
12		complex areas and to report directly to the complex
13		area superintendent for their respective complex
14		areas; provided that each position shall receive
15		guidance and technical support from the enterprise
16		infrastructure services branch within the office of
17		facilities and operations;
18	(4)	Thirty permanent full-time equivalent (30.0 FTE) data
19		processing systems analyst IV positions to assist with
20		complex school connectivity and information technology

needs, to be housed within the complex areas and to

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I		report directly to the complex area superintendent for
2		their respective complex areas; provided that each
3		position shall receive guidance and technical support
4		from the enterprise infrastructure services branch
5		within the office of facilities and operations;
6	(5)	Fifteen permanent full-time equivalent (15.0 FTE)
7		information technology specialist II (IT manager)
8		positions to assist with complex school connectivity
9		and information technology needs, to be housed within
10		the complex areas and to report directly to the
11		complex area superintendent for their respective
12		complex areas; provided that each position shall
13		receive guidance and technical support from the
14		enterprise infrastructure services branch within the
15		office of facilities and operations;
16	(6)	Fifteen permanent full-time equivalent (15.0 FTE)
17		information technology educational specialist
18		positions to assist with complex school connectivity
19		and information technology needs, to be housed within
20		the complex areas and to report directly to the
21		complex area superintendent for their respective

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1		complex areas; provided that each position shall
2		receive guidance and technical support from the
3		enterprise infrastructure services branch within the
4		office of facilities and operations;
5	(7)	Seven permanent full-time equivalent (7.0 FTE)
6		positions to establish a communications branch, to be
7		housed within the office of the superintendent;
8	(8)	Four permanent full-time equivalent (4.0 FTE)
9		positions to establish a video production section, to
10		be housed within the digital design team in the office
11		of curriculum and instructional design;
12	(9)	Six permanent full-time equivalent (6.0 FTE) positions
13		to establish a school improvement and title I team, to
14		be housed within the curriculum innovation branch in
15		the office of curriculum and instructional design;
16	(10)	Three temporary full-time equivalent (3 FTE) positions
17		to establish a community children's council office, to
18		be housed within the special needs section in the
19		office of student support services;
20	(11)	Thirty-two permanent full-time equivalent (32.0 FTE)
21		positions to establish an enterprise infrastructure

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1		services branch, to be housed within the office of
2		facilities and operations;
3	(12)	Six permanent full-time equivalent (6.0 FTE) positions
4		to establish a budget systems section, to be housed
5		within the budget branch in the office of fiscal
6		services;
7	(13)	Five permanent full-time equivalent (5.0 FTE)
8		positions to be housed within the financial management
9		system (FMS) replacement in the office of fiscal
10		services;
11	(14)	Ten permanent full-time equivalent (10.0 FTE)
12		positions to establish a human resources applications
13		section, to be housed within the personnel management
14		branch in the office of talent management;
15	(15)	Four permanent full-time equivalent (4.0 FTE) equity
16		specialist II positions to be housed within the civil
17		rights compliance branch in the office of talent
18		management;
19	(16)	Twelve permanent full-time equivalent (12.0 FTE)
20		positions to establish an assessment and
21		accountability section, to be housed within the

1		monitoring and compliance branch in the office of the
2		deputy superintendent;
3	(17)	One permanent full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) position
4		and one temporary full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE)
5		position to establish a data governance and analysis
6		section, to be housed within the monitoring and
7		compliance branch in the office of the deputy
8		superintendent;
9	(18)	Five permanent full-time equivalent (5.0 FTE)
10		positions to establish a policy and planning section,
11		to be housed within the administrative assistant
12		office in the office of the superintendent; and
13	(19)	Two permanent full-time equivalent (2.0 FTE) positions
14		to be housed within the monitoring and compliance
15		branch in the office of the deputy superintendent.
16	The s	sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
17	of educat	ion for the purposes of this part; provided that no
18	moneys sha	all be released unless expended as provided in this
19	part.
