### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FEDERAL FUNDS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the global
- 2 respiratory disease pandemic named "coronavirus disease 2019",
- 3 or COVID-19, has deeply impacted Hawaii's health and economy.
- 4 The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES
- 5 Act), Public Law 116-136, was enacted on March 27, 2020, to
- 6 address the extensive economic fallout of the COVID-19 pandemic.
- 7 While the CARES Act provided \$1,250,000,000 to Hawaii, of this
- 8 amount, only the city and county of Honolulu received a direct
- 9 allocation of \$387,176,021 for certain specified expenditures.
- The legislature further finds that our governmental
- 11 structure is unique compared to other states. Programs such as
- 12 public education, public safety correctional prisons and jails,
- 13 and hospitals are funded by the State and not the counties. As
- 14 a result, such program and service costs should be supplemented
- 15 by any share of federal moneys designated for the counties. In
- 16 addition, if a county requests services from the National Guard,

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- 1 a portion of those costs should also come out of any specific
- 2 allocation to that county.
- 3 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds received by
- 4 the State from the Act for the purpose of COVID-19
- 5 response and activities with funds for certain programs paid for
- 6 from the county share.
- 7 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the funds received
- 8 by the State of Hawaii from the Act, the sum of \$1 or
- 9 so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2021-2022
- 10 and the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for
- 11 fiscal year 2022-2023 to be used for COVID-19 response conducted
- 12 pursuant to Public Law and associated guidance issued by
- 13 appropriate federal agencies; provided that:
- 14 (1) The amounts appropriated for public education, jails,
- 15 and hospitals shall be provided by the county direct
- 16 allocation, if any; and
- 17 (2) County requests for service from the National Guard
- shall be provided by the county at twenty-five per
- 19 cent of the costs.
- 20 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the for
- 21 the purposes of this Act.

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1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2021.
